Purpose and a brief history

Oregon's QRIS Purpose

- Funded as part of Race to the Top Early Learning Challenge federal grant.
- Raise the quality of child care and early learning programs.
- Provide resources and supports to improve programs.
- Recognize program quality through a rating system.
- Help programs serve and support needs of all children.




What is QRIS?

- $\mathbf{Q} = \mathbf{Q} \cup \mathbf{Q}$
- $\mathbf{R} = \text{Rating}$
- I = Improvement
- $\mathbf{S} = System$

QRIS = Quality for Better Outcomes for Children in Oregon

QRIS Standards Structure

Domains

Overall categories of quality
5 Total

Standards

Program standards, organized by domain
33 Total

Indicators

- Star levels of standards
- Usually 3 per standard
- Some standards only have 1 or 2 indicators

Evidence

 Measurable structural indicators that standard is present in program




Star Level Indicators: Building Block

- Reviewed by experts





Preschool Promise

- HB 3380
- Increase publicly funded preschool opportunities for low income children.
- Families with income up to 200% of federal poverty level.
- Provide high-quality preschool in variety of settings ("mixed delivery").
 - Head Start
 - K-12
 - Community Based Organizations
 - Family/Home Care
 - Child Care Centers


